Thereafter, the remaining shares subject to the option vest and become exercisable in 36 equal monthly installments, at the rate of 4,500 shares per year. The option was exercisable as to 2,660 shares on 3-1-06 prior to the reported exercise.
3. Stock option under the Isis Pharmaceuticals, Inc. 2000 Broad-Based Equity Incentive Plan. 25% of the shares subject to the option vested and became exercisable on 1-2-04. Thereafter, the remaining shares subject to the option vest and become exercisable in 36 equal monthly installments, at the rate of 4,125 shares per year. The option was exercisable as to 12,718 shares on 3-1-06 prior to the reported exercise.
4. Stock option under the Isis Pharmaceuticals, Inc. 2000 Broad-Based Equity Incentive Plan. 25% of the shares subject to the option vested and became exercisable on 1-2-04. Thereafter, the remaining shares subject to the option vest and become exercisable in 36 equal monthly installments, at the rate of 4,125 shares per year. The option was exercisable as to 9,378 shares on 3-2-06 prior to the reported exercise.
